Registration will only be online at www.ACEwise.org beginning Sunday, April 11. **Parents – please be sure to update your student’s information if you have registered in the past.** Instructions for creating your online account are on page four of this brochure, under General Information. All classes will start the week of April 26 and will run for 6 weeks. Classes are limited in size, so please enroll early to assure your spot.

Parents, for your convenience, primary grade students will be loosely monitored in the Leadership Atrium between 2:30 and the 3:00 class time (Wednesdays between 1:40 – 2:00). Be sure to pack an extra snack for your child and a pencil for their homework. Please be aware we have a very strict pick up policy. If you are more than 5 minutes late, you will have one warning then your students will be asked to leave the program. Strict district rules do not allow ANY students to remain on site after 4:00 p.m. unless they are enrolled in the CDC Program.

General Information

HOW TO REGISTER

Registration begins April 11 for classes starting the week of Tuesday, April 26, 2010.

Registration will be done on a first come – first served basis and enrollment is subject to class availability. Irvine students are eligible to attend ACE classes at any ACE school, space permitting.

Register online at www.ACEwise.org

- A. Log onto www.acewise.org
- B. Click on “Parents”
- C. Click on “Create New Profile” to create a log-in and password for yourself.
- D. Once you have successfully created a parent profile, you will be directed to log in.
- E. Click as directed to register a new student. You will need to create a student profile for each child.
- F. To continue enrolling, click on enroll.
- G. Select the class your student is enrolling in.
- H. You may either check out or continue enrolling in another class.
- I. After successfully checking out, you will receive an email receipt listing the class(es) in which your student is enrolled.
- J. To enroll another child, go back to the Home Page and log in again.

If you are unable to complete, or uncomfortable with, the online registration process, please send an email to AlderwoodACE@gmail.com.

REFUNDS: Tuition is nonrefundable unless the class is cancelled by ACE. If your child registers late, misses classes or withdraws before the end of the session, you are still obligated for the full fees for that session. You are eligible for a prorated tuition refund or credit only if your child withdraws due to serious illness or injury, corroborated by a note from your child’s doctor. All refunds are subject to a \$25 non-refundable program fee. Please be advised that refunds may take up to one month to process. If you wish to apply for a refund, please email AlderwoodACE@gmail.com.

FLEX ACCOUNTS: Receipts for dependent care documentation are available on request. Please contact IPSF at (949) 265-6411 with parent name, child’s name, address, phone number and location of ACE class attended.

CLASS AGE LIMITS: In order to develop classes suitable for a particular age range, we specify age limits in the brochure. However, *exceptions are possible* since children display different levels of maturity and ability. Please email AlderwoodACE@gmail.com if your child is interested in a class but doesn’t fit the printed age profile.

CLASS CONFIRMATIONS: Everyone who registers will be notified by e-mail. *To ensure that you receive our messages, please add AlderwoodACE@gmail.com to your address book.*

CLASS LOCATIONS: Class locations will be identified in the class confirmation.

CLASS CANCELLATIONS: We do our best to accommodate all students who sign up for ACE classes. In order to keep class fees as low as possible, we must set a minimum enrollment number for each class to cover the class expenses. If the minimum enrollment is not met, the ACE Program reserves the right to cancel the class and return all registration fees. You will be notified of any cancellations before the first scheduled day of class.

TRANSPORTATION: Getting students to and from class is the responsibility of parents. In the first week of classes, ACE site monitors will attempt to locate registered students who are not present in their class. After that week, however, we expect that the students will know where they should go. If your child has difficulty remembering to go to class, you might want to escort him/her or contact another child in the class so your child has a “buddy” to provide a reminder about class.

ACE students must be picked up immediately after class. Arranging pick

up is the responsibility of parents. School staff, ACE instructors and ACE volunteer monitors are not responsible for your child after class. After class dismissal there will be a five minute grace period for pick-up. After that you will be asked to leave the program.

SNACKS: Your child is always welcome to bring a personal snack. Snacks will *not* be provided by ACE. Please email AlderwoodACE@gmail.com immediately if your child has severe food allergies.

CONDUCT: Normal classroom conduct is expected of all ACE students and we generally have very few problems with the behavior of our students. Children displaying unacceptable behavior will be issued a “Behavior Citation.” If a second citation is necessary, the child must speak to the school principal and may be dismissed without refund. Likewise, if a parent displays unacceptable behavior, his or her child(ren) may be dismissed immediately and without refund.

SCHOLARSHIPS: A limited number of scholarships are available for all classes, based upon need. Evaluation criteria include eligibility for free and reduced lunch and referrals from school staff. Parents may apply for a scholarship covering up to one-half of the tuition fee. Application forms are available by emailing AlderwoodACE@gmail.com.
