Winter 2010 Schedule

(February 2nd to March 24th, Tuesdays and Wednesdays)

Registration is about to begin, so find a computer and prepare to login. Registration will take place online, but please make sure you do it on time! Further, courses are limited in size, so early enrollment is probably wise. The registration dates are listed below, as well as all of the pertinent information you need to know!



Registration will begin Friday, January 8th and conclude Sunday, January 24th.

On Line Registration

Follow the directions below to register your child for ACE.

1. Log onto www.acewise.org.
2. Click on "Parents."
3. Create a login and password by clicking on "Create New Profile." Please keep this information for future reference.
4. Once you have successfully created a "parent profile" you will be directed to login.
5. Click on "Register a new student." You will create a student profile for each child.
6. To enroll, click on "enroll" and then select the class and course # you would like to enroll your child in. The classes are age sensitive and will not permit older or younger students to enroll.
7. After enrolling in one class you may either "check out" or continue enrolling in another class.
8. To enroll another child go back to the home page and login again and repeat steps 5 through 7.
9. Once you have successfully checked out you will receive an email confirmation of registered classes.

A Few Key Points to Remember:

- * Specific classes vary in length from 6 to 8 weeks, so please be very attentive to the dates for each **individual class**. The session (not necessarily the particular class) begins Tuesday, Feb. 3rd and ends (again not all classes) Wednesday, March 24th.
- * For tennis and golf (outdoor programs), classes will be cancelled in the event of rain (only if it is raining during the specific class time). All cancelled classes will be made up in the weeks immediately following the session (specific dates of make-ups will be announced later if necessary).
- * Please bring a snack for your child as they tend to be slightly hungry after school!!!! Thanks!

General Information

Scholarships

A limited number of scholarships are available for all classes based on need. Evaluation criteria include eligibility for free and reduced lunch and referrals from school staff. Transportation Before and After ACE Class

- * Your child should **go to the tables in front of Rainbow Rising** (the ACE “meet point”) - NOT the blue lunch tables - immediately after regularly scheduled school dismissal to be “checked in” by the ACE Coordinators.
- * After grades K-3 have been picked up after school, we will move the children to the blue lunch tables where they can study, eat a snack, color, or play card games during the wait time until the ACE classes start.
- * Ace students **must be picked up immediately** after class **from the blue lunch tables** - arranging pick up is the responsibility of the parent/guardian (note: the ACE meet point and pick up point are different).
- * The School staff, Ace instructors and ACE monitors are not responsible for your child after class.
- * If your child is absent or if s/he will not attend an ACE class you must notify the Ace coordinators **in advance** by emailing meadowparkace@gmail.com.
- * The school is **not** responsible and **will not** pass on messages to ACE or to your child in ACE classes.
- * Please note that ACE will not be providing snacks for any classes; children may bring their own.

Conduct

Children are expected to arrive at the “meet point” promptly. Normal classroom conduct is expected. Children displaying unacceptable behavior will be issued a one-time behavior citation. A second citation will result in a meeting with the principal and possible removal from the class without refund.

Refunds / Class Cancellations

- * Once classes have begun, tuition is generally non-refundable.
- * If you child registers late, misses classes or withdraws before the end of the session, you are still obligated for the full fees for that session. No make-up classes will be offered.
- * You could be eligible for a pro-rated refund if your child withdraws due to serious illness or injury supported by a doctor’s note.
- * All refunds are subject to a \$25 non-refundable program fee.
- * Please note refunds could take up to one month to process and are only processed on Fridays.
- * To keep the class fees as low as possible, there is a minimum enrollment number for each class. In the event the minimum enrollment is not met, the ACE program reserves the right to cancel the class and return all registration fees. You will be notified of any cancellations prior to the first scheduled class (although this could be as late as the day prior to the class start date).
